



**Community Supported Agriculture (CSA)
Summer 2014 Program**

In exchange for a flat rate, our farm provides you with a weekly basket of fresh produce that we grow or have other local farmers grow for us. Some shares also include eggs each week and/or half a hog and 1/8 of a beef steer. **We begin the last week of May** and the program runs for 20 weeks. We also have a winter CSA program, which is one basket per month, November through May. Free-range chickens, turkeys, beef and pork cuts, honey, maple syrup, cooking oils, organic grains and much more are also available as add on items.

Risks and Benefits of a CSA - When one joins a CSA, one accepts some of the risk. By paying up front, the CSA members share with the farmer the risk that a certain percentage of the crops planned in advanced might fail. The benefit to the farmer is that a certain income is assured, even if he doesn't have 100% crop success. The benefit to the CSA member is that they are assured of a steady, weekly supply of produce presented with the knowledge that the produce is grown free of pesticides and chemical fertilizers. The CSA member can visit our farm and know that their money is supporting the local economy. There are no refunds for any portion of the CSA program.

Pick Up Locations and Times - Pick up will be at the Lakewood Screw Factory parking lot on Monday evenings, our farm on Tuesday evenings, at the Oberlin library parking lot on Wednesday evenings and at the Friendship Church in North Olmsted (Great Northern Blvd) Wednesday evenings. Detailed pick-up times will be made available at the start of the season. Scheduled pick up times must be adhered to. It is the member's responsibility to make arrangements to have their share picked up at the set time. If a share is not picked up it will not be refunded or made up at another date. Other pickup/delivery arrangements can be made and may involve a delivery fee. Additional drop off points may be added during the season.

On-Farm Pickups and Visits - We welcome our members to walk around and enjoy the animals and gardens. In doing so, we ask that you carefully monitor your children. It is important that your children not be left unattended and that they do not touch any of our equipment for their own safety. Livestock are protected by electric fencing; please do not enter fenced areas without an escort. We also ask that NO DOGS be allowed on the property, for the protection of our livestock. We thank you in advance for your cooperation and consideration.

How To Join - Please fill out your information at the top of this sheet, indicate which type of share you are interested in and where you would like to pick up your share. All fees are to be paid in full before August 1, 2014. We only have a limited number of shares available for the 2014 season. Shares are sold on a first-come, first-served basis.

Payment plans are available as shown below, effective 2/1/2014: (other arrangements can be made, please inquire)

By paying up front you are helping us determine how many shares will need to be filled for the season so we can plan our planting schedule. We then have the necessary capital to carry on the day-to-day farm activities. You may choose to pay monthly, one month in advance, but please send the first month's payment as your deposit.
